- Attend one face-to-face Council meeting in August each year.
- Respond promptly to emails and phone calls on certain issues that need Council consideration/approval.
- Support and participate in the dissemination of information to women in your region via various communications (interviews, radio, social media, event participation, etc.):

Council Member practical experience and knowledge

- Working knowledge of Microsoft Suite.
- Fluent in one or more of Nunavut's official languages (Inuktitut, Inuinnaqtun, English, French).
- Ability to serve as spokesperson and representative on behalf of the Council if needed.
- Ability and willingness to travel.
- Experience and knowledge of Indigenous Women's issues and challenges.
- Resident of Nunavut.

Term of Council Member

- Council members serve 1 to 3 year terms on the Council. This is a volunteer position, however, Council members are provided per diems and a honorarium for meetings.
